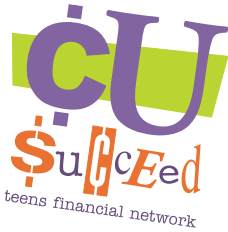


## What is it?

## CU Succeed Scholarship

Every year, Arizona Central Credit Union awards two (2) \$2,000 CU Succeed Scholarships to eligible graduating high school seniors.<sup>4</sup>

### Who is eligible:

- ◆ Graduating high school seniors with a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- ◆ Applicants must be a primary member of Arizona Central
- ◆ Recipients must maintain their credit union membership in good standing to remain eligible
- ◆ Must be accepted to and plan on attending full-time (12 credit hours minimum both semesters) at an accredited college, university, community college, or technical/trade school located in Arizona

### Scholarship details and eligibility:

- ◆ Scholarships are renewable each year for a maximum of four consecutive years
- ◆ Recipients must attend consecutive fall and spring semesters as a full-time student (minimum 12 credit hours both semesters)
- ◆ A minimum GPA of 2.5 must be maintained each semester and have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
- ◆ \$1,000 will be paid upon proof of registration for the fall semester following high school graduation
- ◆ Upon proof of successful completion of the fall semester, an additional \$1,000 will be paid upon proof of registration for the spring semester
